


ITINERARY

SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 4 – Our pilgrimage begins as we depart the United States on our international flight.

MONDAY, FEBRUARY 5 – We will be welcomed by our representative and taken to our hotel in the **Tel Aviv** area. There we will have dinner and overnight.

TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 6 – We'll begin our day with a drive along the coast of the **Mediterranean Sea** to **Caesarea by the Sea**. There we'll see the Roman ruins of the great **Theater** and **Aqueduct**, as well as the **Crusader city** later built on this site. This is the place where Paul left for his final missionary journey. We'll continue to **Mt. Carmel** where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal. Next we'll travel to **Megiddo**, also known as **Armageddon**. This is the place where many Christians believe the final great battle of the world will be fought. We'll travel to **Nazareth** where the angel appeared to Mary to announce that she would be the mother of God's Son. This is also the place where Jesus spent his childhood years. From there we'll travel through **Cana** where Jesus performed his first miracle as we proceed to **Tiberias** for dinner and overnight.


WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 7 – Today we'll begin with a **Boat Ride** across the **Sea of Galilee** where we'll stop for a devotional service. We'll continue to **Caesarea Philippi** at the foot of **Mount Hermon**, the ancient Roman city where Peter first confessed Jesus as the Christ. After our visit there we'll go to view the **Road to Damascus** where Paul had his conversion experience. We'll continue our tour with a visit to the hills above the Sea where we find the **Mount of Beatitudes**. It was here that Jesus gave us the beautiful words from Matthew's gospel. We'll end our day with a visit to **Peter's Primacy**, a beautiful garden on the shores of the **Sea of Galilee** with a chapel commemorating the morning meal that Jesus prepared for the disciples after the resurrection. After our visit there we'll return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 8 – Today we'll begin with a visit to **Capernaum**, the area where Jesus spent most of his ministry. After the visit here we will visit the newly excavated site of **Magdala** to see the synagogue from the time of Jesus. We'll continue to **Beit She'an** where we'll visit the Roman ruins of the ancient Decapolis city which was continuously inhabited for 5000 years. We'll end our day with a **Baptism** service at the **Jordan River** before we return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 9 – We'll leave Tiberias after breakfast and continue our adventure by traveling to the **Sheikh Hussein Bridge** where we'll cross the border to **Jordan**. We will view the **Jabbok River** where Jacob wrestled with the angel, on our way to **Jerash** where we'll see the ruins of another Decapolis city. We'll continue to the **Dead Sea** to check in to our hotel on the shores of this unique body of water. Dinner and overnight will be at this beautiful resort.

SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 10 – This morning we'll travel to the traditional site of the **baptism of Jesus in Jordan** near the **Dead Sea**. This area was excavated and opened for the visit of the Pope in 2000. There is a **Byzantine monastery** and **three churches** that have been excavated, along with a series of shallow pools believed to have been used for baptism when the site became a pilgrimage center in early Christianity. We will continue to **Mount Nebo** from where Moses viewed the Promised Land. From there we will go to the Christian village of **Madaba** to see the ancient mosaic map of the Holy land. After our visit there we'll continue to **Petra** for dinner and overnight.

SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 11 – This morning we'll visit the beautiful Red Rose City of **Petra**. This 2000-year old city was carved by the Nabataens out of the native rock. It has been protected through the centuries by a ring of mountains surrounding the area. Choose between riding a horse or walking to the dramatic canyon where we'll then all walk to the famous **Treasury**, carved in pink stone. We will continue past



the **Roman Theatre**, the **Corinthian Tomb** and the **Palace Tomb** to the **Roman Road**. After our visit there, we will return to the **Dead Sea** resort for dinner and overnight.

MONDAY, FEBRUARY 12 – This morning we'll cross the border back into Israel and drive to **Masada**, the amazing mountain-top fortress built by Herod and site of the final battle in the Jewish Rebellion against the Romans. After our visit there, we'll drive along the **Dead Sea**, passing the springs of **Ein Gedi**, and drive through the **Judean Wilderness** on our way up to **Jerusalem** for dinner and overnight.

TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 13 – Today's tour begins with a visit to the **Mount of Olives** where we'll see a breathtaking **Panoramic View** of the **Old City of Jerusalem**. We'll walk a part of the **Palm Sunday Road** to the **Garden of Gethsemane** where Jesus went with the disciples on the final night before his crucifixion. There we'll visit the **Church of All Nations** and the garden with its ancient olive trees. Next we'll go to **Mount Zion** where we'll see the **Upper Room** and then on to the **House of Caiaphas** where Jesus was imprisoned for a night. Finally, we'll return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 14 – Our day will begin today with a visit to the **Temple Mount** where we'll view the **Dome of the Rock Mosque**. We'll continue from there to the **Pool of Bethesda** where Jesus healed the crippled man. We'll sing a hymn in the **Church of St. Anne** before we begin our walk down the **Via Dolorosa**, following the path Jesus took to the cross. We'll visit the **Church of the Holy Sepulcher** and walk through the fascinating **Arab market**. We'll continue to the **Western Wall**, the place most precious for Jews around the world, where we'll have some time to pray and place our prayers in the wall. We'll proceed to the **Western Wall Tunnel** that runs the length of the wall from the time of Jesus and is underneath the city of today. We'll tour through the **Jewish Quarter** where we'll see the **Roman Cardo** and other sites of interest. At the end of our visit there, we'll return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 15 – Today we'll begin with a visit to the **Elah Valley** where David confronted Goliath. We'll view the **Israeli Knesset**, seat of the Israeli Parliament and government offices on our way to the **Israel Museum** to see the **Dead Sea Scrolls**. We'll continue with a tour of the **Model of First Century Jerusalem** and finish the day with a visit to the **Nativity Church in Bethlehem**. There we'll see the cave revered by Christians throughout the centuries as the place where Jesus was born. We'll view the **Shepherd's Fields** as we travel between Jerusalem and Bethlehem. This is where the angels appeared to the shepherds to announce the birth of Jesus. After our visit there we'll return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 16 – Today we will return to the Old City for a **culinary and tasting visit with the Chefs for Peace** - Christian, Jewish and Moslem chefs who will lead us through the Old City tasting and shopping for ingredients for our lunch. We will have a cooking class and enjoy preparing our lunch with these three chefs! We'll finish our visit in the Holy Land with a very special service of **Communion at the Garden Tomb**. We'll return to the hotel for our **Farewell Dinner** and overnight.

SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 17 – This morning we will go to the airport for our flight back to the USA. We'll arrive home with new insights and understandings of the life teachings of Jesus.



PROGRAM CONDITIONS

INCLUDED IN PRICE OF STANDARD PROGRAM: Round trip airfare, transfers with group to/from airport; shared double room in moderate hotel; two meals daily; English speaking guide; transfer to and entrance fees for sites to be visited.

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE: Tips of \$260 to be collected and distributed by tour operator; Single room charges (see below); Additions or changes to the standard program (see below); individual transfers; travel insurance; laundry, coffee and drinks; excess baggage and items of a personal nature; any increase in taxes and fees that may occur between the printing of this brochure and issuing of airline tickets. Price is based on the exchange rate at the time of printing and may be subject to change. Additional charge of \$221 for double occupancy and \$275 for single occupancy to pay by credit card.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE: Deposit of \$500 due with registration. Final payment is due November 4, 2017.

SINGLE ROOMS: When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. Single room supplement is \$1200.

ROOMMATES: You will be charged for a single room if you do not have a roommate and/or Gomega Travel cannot match you with one.

MEALS: Buffet breakfast and set menu dinner daily. All other meals are "on your own".

LUGGAGE: Limit of one suitcase and one carry-on per person, not to exceed 50 pounds or 62 inches total.

TRANSFERS: Transport between airport, hotel and piers is included in the standard program. However, those who request changes from standard program are responsible for their own transfers even when coinciding with group transfers.

CHANGES FROM STANDARD PROGRAM: Changes must be requested and approved in writing by Gomega Travel. A minimum of \$150 will be charged and transfers to/from airports, etc. are not included.

AIRLINE TICKETS: Printed 45 days prior to departure, tickets cannot be changed or refunded thereafter. Air transportation to/from your European destination will be jet economy class aboard IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amenable tickets for groups of 10 or more passengers flying together for entire itinerary.

FLIGHT TIMES: Subject to change by airlines without advance notice. Gomega Travel is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays.

ITINERARY LENGTH: Because airlines often change flight schedules after brochures are printed, Gomega Travel reserves the right to shorten or lengthen the itinerary accordingly and, whenever possible, you will be notified in writing. If changes necessitate extra overnights, there will be additional charges.

CANCELLATION FEES: From the day of registration to 120 days prior to departure the \$100 non-refundable registration fee is the only charge. Thereafter, the following charges apply: 119-90 days: \$500; 89-60 days: 50% of total cost; 59-45 days: 75% of total cost; 44 days to day of departure: 100% of total cost. All refund claims must be received in writing.

INSURANCE: Gomega Travel strongly recommends cancellation and trip insurance to cover the above fees. The cost for insurance for this tour based on double occupancy is \$397 per person, \$550 for single occupancy. This amount covers the comprehensive insurance package including the pre-departure cancellation and the post-departure trip interruption benefits.
