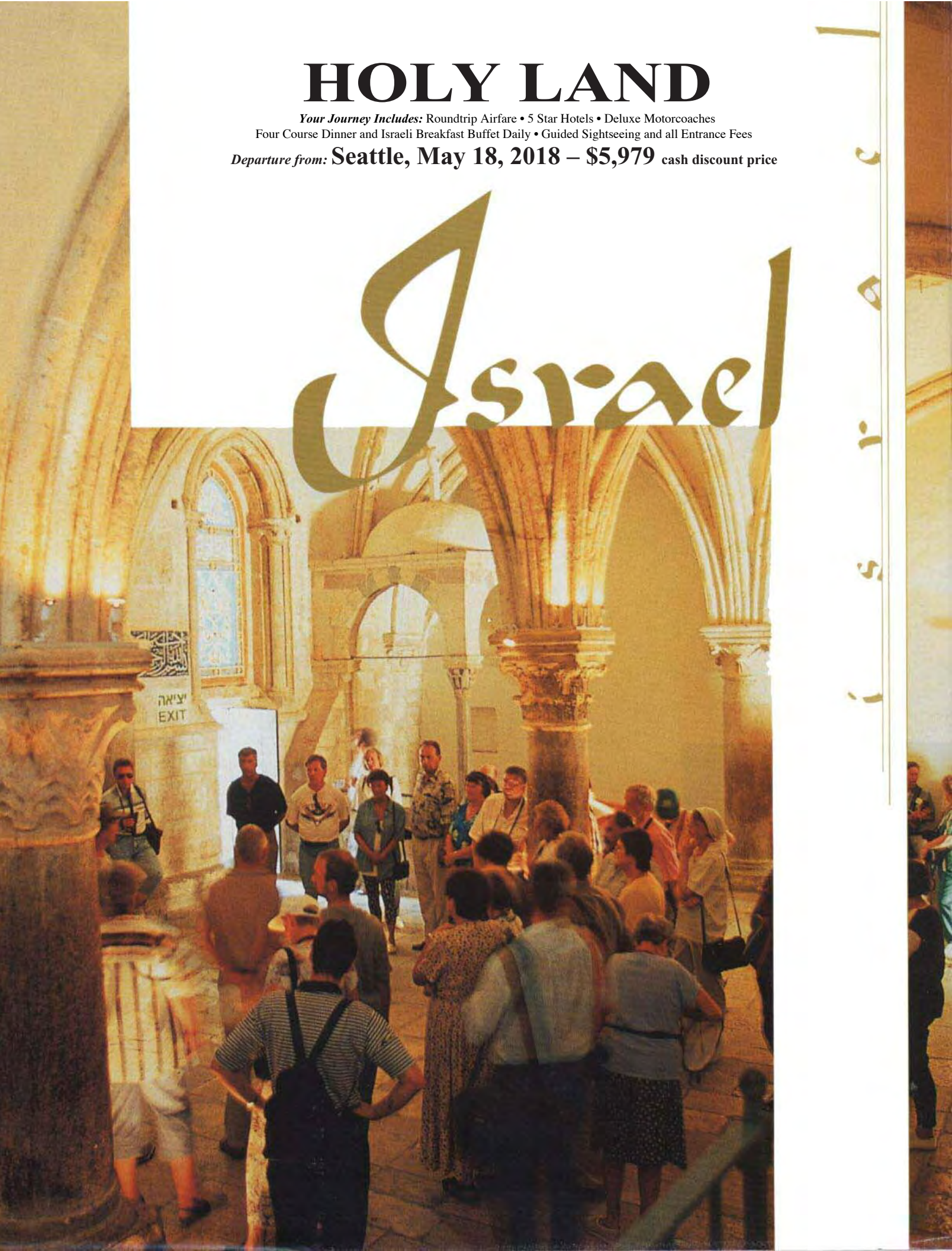

ITINERARY

FRIDAY, MAY 18 – Your pilgrimage begins as you depart the United States on your international flight.

SATURDAY, MAY 19 – You will be welcomed by your representative and taken to your hotel in the **Tel Aviv** area. There you will have dinner and overnight.

SUNDAY, MAY 20 – You'll begin your day with a drive along the coast of the **Mediterranean Sea** to **Caesarea Maritima**. There you'll see the Roman ruins of the great Theater and Aqueduct, as well as the Crusader city later built on this site. This is the place where Paul left for his final missionary journey. You'll continue to **Mt. Carmel** where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal. Next you'll travel to **Megiddo**, also known as **Armageddon**. This is the place where Christians believe the final great battle of the world will be fought. You'll travel to **Nazareth** where the angel appeared to Mary to announce that she would be the mother of God's Son. This is also the place where Jesus spent his childhood years. From there you'll drive through **Cana** where Jesus performed his first miracle as you proceed to **Tiberias** for dinner and overnight.

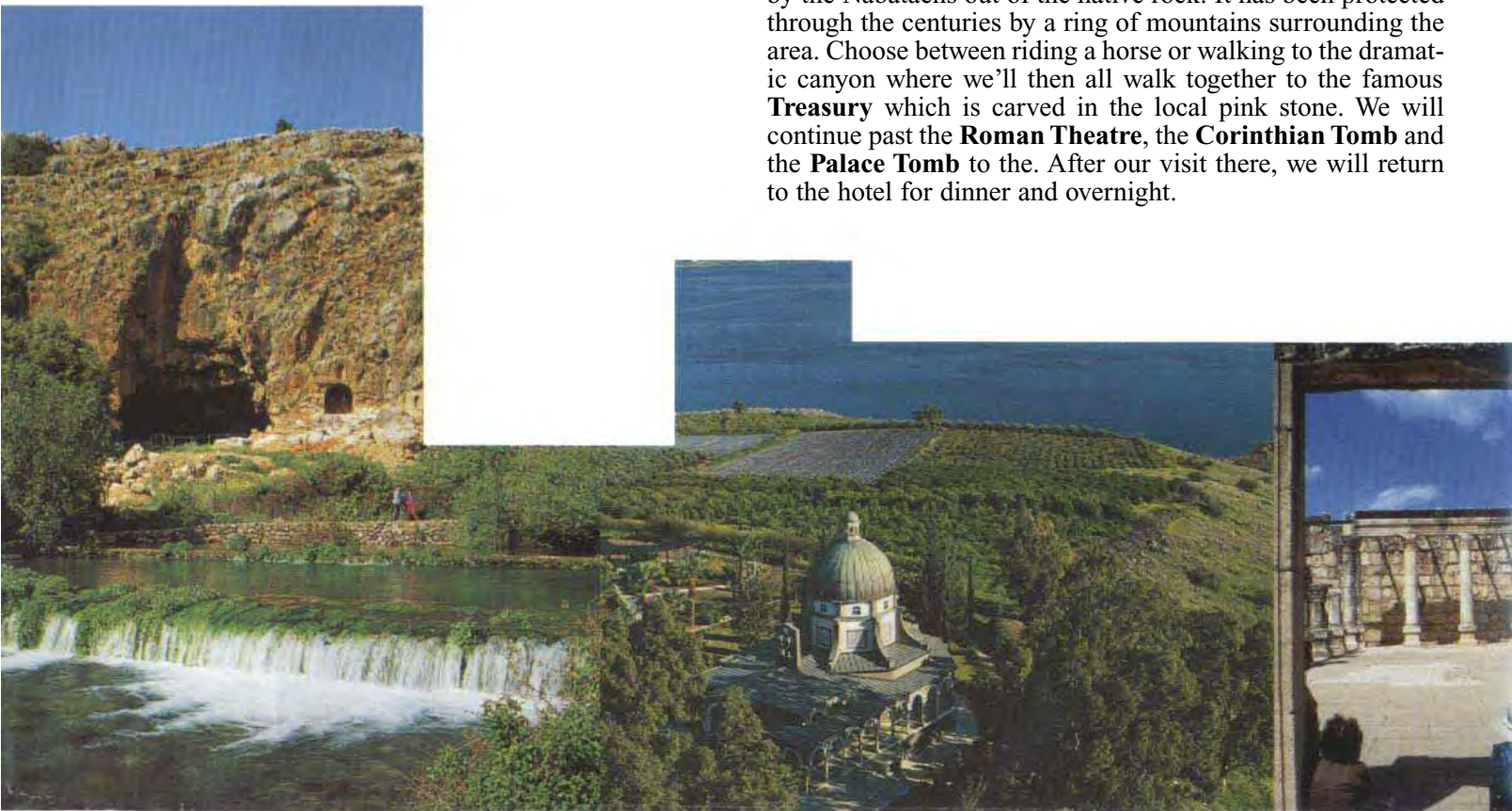
MONDAY, MAY 21 - This morning you will drive north to **Dan**, the northernmost city of Israel in the Old Testament, for all practical purposes. Tel Dan is a beautiful nature reserve where one of the three tributaries of the Jordan River begins. Here you'll see a fascinating complex of city gates from various time periods. When you read through the Old Testament you learn how important the city gates were in the culture of that time. From there you'll drive to **Caesarea Phillipi** at the foot of **Mount Hermon**, the ancient Roman city where Peter first confessed Jesus as the Son of the living God. Along the drive, you will see the **Road to Damascus** where Paul had his conversion experience. You'll continue to **Capernaum**, the area where Jesus spent most of his ministry. You'll travel on to **Tabgha**, the site of the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes. You'll finish your day with a **Boat Ride** on the Sea of Galilee where you'll stop for a devotional service before returning to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

TUESDAY, MAY 22 – Today you'll begin your day with a visit to **Kibbutz Ginosar** where you'll see the **Ancient Boat** from the time of Jesus. You'll continue from there to the hills above the Sea where we find the **Mount of Beatitudes**. It was here that Jesus gave us the beautiful words from Matthew's gospel. You will continue with a drive to **Zippori**, not far from Nazareth and a center of learning during the time of Jesus. You'll see the beautiful mosaics and get a feel for the area where Jesus grew up. You'll drive from there to **Beit She'an**. You'll visit the Roman ruins of this ancient Decapolis city which was continuously inhabited for 5000 years. After your time there you'll finish the day at the **Jordan River** before returning to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

WEDNESDAY, MAY 23 – This morning you'll travel along the **Jordan Valley** on your way to **Masada**, the amazing mountain-top fortress built by Herod and site of the final battle in the Jewish Rebellion against the Romans. After your visit there, you'll drive along the **Dead Sea**, stopping for a view of the spring of **Ein Gedi**. From there you'll go to visit **Qumran** where the **Dead Sea Scrolls** were discovered. You'll finish your day with a drive through the **Judean Wilderness** on your way up to **Jerusalem** for dinner and overnight.

THURSDAY, MAY 24 – This morning we'll travel to the **Allenby Bridge** and cross the border to Jordan. We'll visit the traditional site of the baptism of Jesus in Jordan near the Dead Sea. This area was excavated and opened for the visit of the Pope in 2000. There is a Byzantine monastery and three churches that have been excavated, along with a series of shallow pools believed to have been used for baptism when the site became a pilgrimage center in early Christianity. We will continue to **Mount Nebo** from where Moses viewed the Promised Land. From there we will go to the Christian village of **Madaba** to see the ancient mosaic map of the Holy Land. After our visit there we'll continue to **Petra** for dinner and overnight.

FRIDAY, MAY 25 – This morning we'll visit the beautiful **Red Rose City** of **Petra**. This 2000-year old city was carved by the Nabataens out of the native rock. It has been protected through the centuries by a ring of mountains surrounding the area. Choose between riding a horse or walking to the dramatic canyon where we'll then all walk together to the famous **Treasury** which is carved in the local pink stone. We will continue past the **Roman Theatre**, the **Corinthian Tomb** and the **Palace Tomb** to the. After our visit there, we will return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.



SATURDAY, MAY 26 – This morning you'll drive to **Kerak** where you will visit one of the largest Crusader castles in the Middle East. From there you will continue to the **Dead Sea** for an opportunity to relax in the mineral waters of that unique body of water before dinner and overnight.

SUNDAY, MAY 27 – This morning you will cross back into Israel and drive up to Jerusalem to the **Mount of Olives** where you'll see a breathtaking Panoramic View of the **Old City of Jerusalem**. You'll view the **Temple Mount** and the **Dome of the Rock Mosque** as well as other sites of interest in and around the Old City walls. You'll walk a part of the **Palm Sunday Road** to the **Garden of Gethsemane** where Jesus went with the disciples on the final night before his crucifixion. You'll visit the **Church of All Nations** and the garden with its ancient olive trees. From there you'll go to the **Israel Museum** which houses the Dead Sea Scrolls and artifacts found in the caves with the scrolls. You'll also see the **Model of First Century Jerusalem** and view the **Knesset**, home of the Israeli Parliament. You'll return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

MONDAY, MAY 28 – This morning you will visit the **Western Wall**, the place most precious for Jews around the world. You'll walk through the tunnel that goes under the streets of today with pavement from the time of Jesus. You'll continue from there to the **Pool of Bethesda** where Jesus healed the crippled man. You'll sing a hymn in the **Church of St. Anne** before you begin the walk down the **Via Dolorosa**, following the path Jesus took to the cross. You'll visit the **Church of the Holy Sepulcher** and walk through the fascinating Arab market. You'll tour the Jewish Quarter where you'll see the Roman Cardo and other sites of interest. At the end of your visit there, you'll return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

TUESDAY, MAY 29 – This morning you'll begin with a visit to the **House of Caiaphas** where Jesus was imprisoned for a night. Next you'll go to **Mount Zion** where we'll see the **Upper Room** where you'll remember the Last Supper, as well as Pentecost. From there you'll go to the **Temple Institute**, an organization focusing on preparing everything that will be needed in the Third Temple. After your visit there you will go to the **Herodian Quarter** and the **Burnt House** in the Jewish Quarter of the Old City. There you will see charred remains of the homes of wealthy 1st century residents of Jerusalem, with evidence of the destruction of Jerusalem in 70 AD. From

there you will continue to **Davidson Center** where you will see an introductory film before visiting the excavations at the **Southern Wall of the Temple Mount**. This is where the main entrance to the Temple at the time of Jesus was located. At the end of your visit there you will return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

WEDNESDAY, MAY 30 – This morning you will begin your visit in Jerusalem at the **City of David**. You will visit **King David's Palace**, **Pier Warren**, the water system of Jerusalem from the time of King David, and **Hezekiah's Tunnel**. Next you'll visit the excavations at the **Pool of Siloam** (fed by the waters of the Gihon Springs) where Jesus told the blind man to wash himself and his sight was restored. Following your visit you will return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

THURSDAY, MAY 31 - We'll begin our day with a drive to **Bethlehem** where we'll visit the **Nativity Church** and see **Manger Square**. On our way to the church we'll view the **Shepherd's Field** where the angels appeared to the shepherds to announce the birth of Jesus. After your time there, you will return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

FRIDAY, JUNE 1 – You will begin today with a visit to **Yad Vashem**, the memorial to the Holocaust victims. From there you will drive outside the city to **Neot Kedumim**, a Biblical garden which depicts life as it was lived in Biblical times. We'll continue to the **Elah Valley**, the site of the battle between the Israelites and Philistines that ended with the famous confrontation between David and Goliath. Next you'll go to **Tel Lachish**, where God delivered Hezekiah and the people of Jerusalem from the hand of Sennacherib, king of Assyria. From there you will go to **Emmaus** to visit the Byzantine church and monastery where you will commemorate the encounter between Jesus and two of his followers after the resurrection. From there you will return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

SATURDAY, JUNE 2 – This morning you will begin with worship at the **Jerusalem Assembly**, a Messianic congregation in Jerusalem. After your time there you will go to the **Garden Tomb** for a visit and a time of communion. After your time there you will return to the hotel for time to pack before the Farewell Dinner and overnight.

SUNDAY, JUNE 3 – This morning you will have an early departure for the airport to check in for your return flight to the USA. You'll arrive home filled with new insights and understanding of the life and land of Jesus.

PROGRAM CONDITIONS

INCLUDED IN PRICE OF STANDARD PROGRAM: Round trip airfare, transfers with group to/from airport; shared double room in moderate hotel; two meals daily; English speaking guide; transfer to and entrance fees for sites to be visited.

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE: Tips of \$340 to be collected and distributed by tour operator; Single room charges (see below); Additions or changes to the standard program (see below); individual transfers; travel insurance; laundry, coffee and drinks; excess baggage and items of a personal nature; **any increase in taxes and fees that may occur between the printing of this brochure and issuing of airline tickets.** Price is based on the exchange rate at the time of printing and may be subject to change. Additional charge of \$270 for double occupancy and \$353 for single occupancy to pay by credit card.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE: Deposit of \$500 due with registration. Final payment is due February 13, 2018.

SINGLE ROOMS: When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. Single room supplement is \$1850.

ROOMMATES: You will be charged for a single room if you do not have a roommate and/or Omega Travel cannot match you with one.

MEALS: Buffet breakfast and set menu dinner daily. All other meals are "on your own".

LUGGAGE: Limit of one suitcase and one carry-on per person, not to exceed 50 pounds or 62 inches total.

TRANSFERS: Transport between airport, hotel and piers is included in the standard program. However, those who request changes from standard program are responsible for their own transfers even when coinciding with group transfers.

CHANGES FROM STANDARD PROGRAM: Changes must be requested and approved in writing by Omega Travel. A minimum of \$150 will be charged and transfers to/from airports, etc. are not included.

AIRLINE TICKETS: Printed 45 days prior to departure, tickets cannot be changed or refunded thereafter. Air transportation to/from your European destination will be jet economy class aboard IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amenable tickets for groups of 10 or more passengers flying together for entire itinerary.

FLIGHT TIMES: Subject to change by airlines without advance notice. Omega Travel is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays.

ITINERARY LENGTH: Because airlines often change flight schedules after brochures are printed, Omega Travel reserves the right to shorten or lengthen the itinerary accordingly and, whenever possible, you will be notified in writing. If changes necessitate extra overnights, there will be additional charges.

CANCELLATION FEES: From the day of registration to 120 days prior to departure the \$100 non-refundable registration fee is the only charge. Thereafter, the following charges apply: 119-90 days: \$500; 89-60 days: 50% of total cost; 59-45 days: 75% of total cost; 44 days to day of departure: 100% of total cost. All refund claims must be received in writing.

INSURANCE: Omega Travel strongly recommends cancellation and trip insurance to cover the above fees. Insurance is \$472 for double occupancy and \$629 for single occupancy.
