ITINERARY DAYS 1-3

DAY 1 | ARRIVE IN ISRAEL

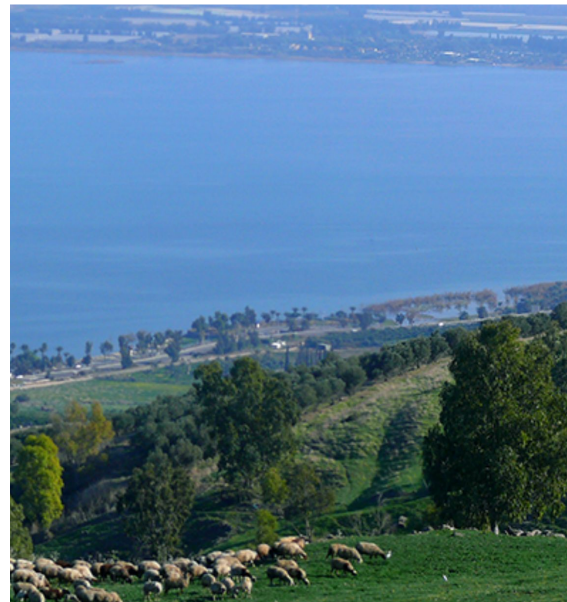
You will be welcomed by our representative and taken to your hotel in the Tel Aviv area. There you will have dinner and overnight.

DAY 2 | CAESAREA - NAZARETH

You'll begin your day with a drive along the coast of the Mediterranean Sea to Caesarea by the Sea. There you'll see the Roman ruins of the great Theater and Aqueduct, as well as the Crusader city later built on this site. This is the place where Paul left for his final missionary journey. You'll continue to Mt. Carmel where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal. Next you'll travel to Megiddo, also known as Armageddon. This is the place where Christians believe the final great battle of the world will be fought. You'll travel to Nazareth where the angel appeared to Mary to announce that she would be the mother of God's Son. This is also the place where Jesus spent his childhood years. From there you'll drive through Cana where Jesus performed his first miracle as you proceed to Tiberias for dinner and overnight.

DAY 3 | SEA OF GALILEE

Today you'll begin with a boat ride across the Sea of Galilee where you'll stop for a devotional service. You'll then visit Kibbutz Ginosar where you'll see the ancient boat from the time of Jesus. You'll continue to the Road to Damascus where Paul had his conversion experience. Next you'll visit Caesarea Phillipi at the foot of Mount Hermon, the ancient Roman city where Peter first confessed Jesus as the son of the living God. You'll travel on to Tabgha, the site of the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes. From there you'll continue your tour with a visit to the hills above the Sea where you'll find the Mount of Beatitudes. It was here that Jesus gave us the beautiful words from Matthew's gospel. You'll finish your day at Capernaum, the area where Jesus spent most of his ministry, and then return to your hotel in Tiberias for dinner and overnight.





ITINERARY DAYS 4-6

DAY 4 | BEIT SHEAN - ZIPPORI - JORDAN RIVER

Today you'll begin with a drive to see the Roman ruins at Beit Shean, which was continuously inhabited for 5000 years. From there you'll continue to Zippori, not far from Nazareth and a center of learning during the time of Jesus. You'll see the beautiful mosaics and get a feel for the area where Jesus grew up. You'll end your day with a visit to the Jordan River before you return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.



DAY 5 | MASADA - DEAD SEA

This morning you'll travel along the Jordan Valley on your way to Masada, the amazing mountaintop fortress built by Herod and site of the final battle of the Jewish Rebellion against the Romans. After your visit there, you'll drive along the Dead Sea, passing the springs of Ein Gedi on your way to visit Qumran where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. After your visit there, you'll go to the Dead Sea where you'll have an opportunity to go down to the water to touch it or to float at the lowest point on earth! You'll finish your day with a drive through the Judean Wilderness on your way up to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

DAY 6 | JERUSALEM

Today's tour begins at the Mount of Olives where we'll see a breathtaking Panoramic View of the Old City of Jerusalem. You'll view the Temple Mount with the Dome of the Rock Mosque at the center of the picture, as well as other sites of interest in and near the Old City. You'll walk a part of the Palm Sunday Road to the Garden of Gethsemane where Jesus went with the disciples on the final night before his crucifixion. There you'll visit the Church of All Nations and the garden with its ancient olive trees. Next you'll go to Mount Zion where you'll see the Upper Room and King David's Tomb. From there you'll go to the House of Caiaphas where Jesus was imprisoned for a night. Finally you'll return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.



ITINERARY DAYS 7-10

DAY 7 | JERUSALEM

Your day will begin with a visit to the Western Wall, the place most precious for Jews around the world. You'll walk through the tunnel that goes under the streets of today with pavement from the time of Jesus. You'll continue from there to the Pool of Bethesda where Jesus healed the crippled man. You'll sing a hymn in the Church of St. Anne before you walk down the Via Dolorosa, following the path Jesus took to the cross. You'll visit the Church of the Holy Sepulcher and walk through the fascinating Arab market. You'll tour the Jewish Quarter where you'll see the Roman Cardo and other sites of interest. At the end of your visit there, you'll return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 8 | JERUSALEM

You'll begin your day with a drive to Bethlehem where you'll visit the Nativity Church and see Manger Square. On your way to the church you'll view the Shepherd's Field where the angels appeared to the shepherds to announce the birth of Jesus. Today you'll go to Yad Vashem, the memorial to the Holocaust victims. Nearby, you'll visit the Israel Museum which houses the Dead Sea Scrolls. We'll view the Israeli Knesset, seat of the Israeli Parliament and government offices and finish the day with a tour of the Model of First Century Jerusalem before returning to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 9 | GARDEN TOMB

Today you'll finish your visit in the Holy Land with a very special service of Communion at the Garden Tomb. You'll return to your hotel for your farewell dinner and overnight.

DAY 10 | FAREWELL

You'll depart for the airport to check in for your flight to the USA. You'll arrive home filled with new insights and understanding of the life and land of Jesus.

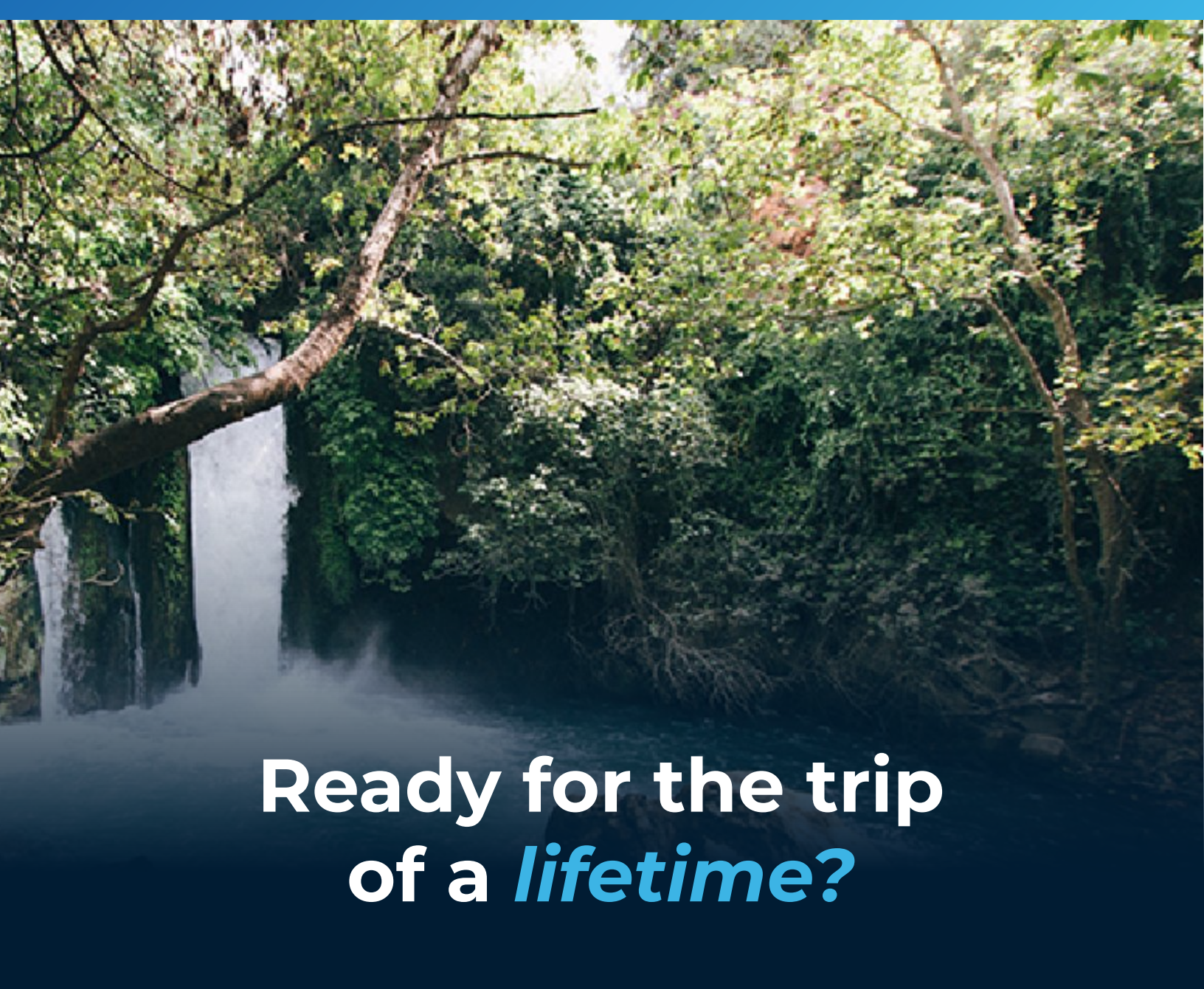

PROGRAM CONDITIONS INCLUDED IN PRICE OF STANDARD FULL TOUR PROGRAM: Round trip economy airfare; transfers with group to/from airport; shared double room in moderate hotel; two meals daily; English speaking guide; transfers to/from and entrance fees for sites to be visited per itinerary. Gratuities'

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE: Additions or changes to the standard full tour program; individual transfers; travel insurance; any Covid testing required to travel both in the US and internationally, laundry; coffee and drinks; excess baggage and items of a personal nature; any increase in taxes and fees that may occur between registration and issuing of airline tickets. The price is based on the exchange rate at the time of registration and may be subject to change.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE: Deposit of \$750 due with registration of which \$500 per person is non-refundable. Deadline for registration is TBC, 2024. Final payment date is no later than TBC, 2024.

TOUR DOCUMENTS: The name on your airline ticket must exactly match your name as it appears on your passport which must be uploaded before we can purchase your airline ticket. If applying for a new or renewed passport, upload a copy as soon as you receive your new passport.

ROOMMATES: If you purchase double occupancy and are unable to find a roommate, or your roommate cancels, you will be charged the single room occupancy rate.

LUGGAGE: Limit of one suitcase and one carry-on per person, not to exceed 50 pounds or 62 linear inches total.

TRANSFERS: Group transport between airport, hotel and piers is included in the standard program. However, those who request changes from the standard program are responsible for their own transfers. Transfer costs may vary by trip brochure.

CHANGES FROM STANDARD FULL TOUR PROGRAM: Changes must be requested and approved in writing by GOMEGA Travel and Tours. A minimum of \$150 will be charged and individual transfers to/ from the airport are not included.

AIRLINE TICKETS: Tickets are nonrefundable; any changes are subject to the specific airline's policies.
