Day 1 | Depart for Greece

Depart from Houston Intercontinental Airport on your flight to Thessaloniki, Greece.

Day 2 | Arrive in Thessaloniki

Upon arrival, transfer from Thessaloniki airport to your hotel for the evening.

Day 3 | Philippi | Kavala | Thessaloniki

After breakfast, you will visit Philippi, a key city in Macedonia during Paul's time, where he and Silas met Lydia. You'll see the cell where they were imprisoned, the site of their beating, and part of the Ignatian Road. Next, you'll continue to Kavala, the ancient port of Neapolis, where Paul first landed in Macedonia. Enjoy some free time to explore the scenic port. On the return to Thessaloniki, you'll stop at the ramparts where Jason's house was located. Dinner and overnight will be in Thessaloniki.

Day 4 | Thessaloniki | Veria | Vergina | Kalambaka

After breakfast, enjoy a panoramic tour of Thessaloniki, where Paul preached. You'll see the Arch of Galerius, Aristoteles Square, and the ancient Agora before visiting the 5th-century church of St. Dimitri, built on the ruins of an ancient synagogue. Following in Paul's footsteps, travel to Veria to see the Bema, where he spoke to Jews and Greeks. Then, head to Vergina to visit Philip II's tomb, father of Alexander the Great. Finally, continue to Kalambaka for dinner and overnight stay.

Day 5 | Meteora | Delphi

After breakfast, you will be picked up from your hotel and driven to breathtaking Meteora, a geological phenomenon. You will visit the world-famous Byzantine monasteries perched precariously atop rock formations of varied and beautiful shapes. From there, you will drive to Delphi, stopping on the way to see Thermopylae, the site of the world-famous battle and the monument dedicated to King Leonidas and the 300 Spartans. Dinner and overnight in Delphi.

Athons

Day 6 | Delphi | Athens

After breakfast, you will visit Delphi, which is located at the foot of Mount Parnassos, at a height of approximately 2000 feet, and is considered to be the most impressive and spectacular archaeological site in Greece. You will take the sacred way to the Athenian Treasury, the temple of Apollo, and the theatre. You will also visit the museum, where you will see the unique bronze charioteer and other treasures. From Delphi, you will drive to Athens. Dinner and overnight in Athens.

Day 7 | Athens

After breakfast, you will visit the world-renowned Acropolis, and the new Acropolis Museum, considered to be technologically the best museum in Europe. As you enter you will walk on a crystal under which you see the ruins of the ancient city. Inside, you will see treasures that were found in the Acropolis during excavations, including the famous frieze of the Parthenon designed by the great Pheidias. Dinner and overnight in Athens.

Day 8 | Greek Island Cruise to Mykonos

After breakfast and hotel check-out, you will travel to the port of Lavrio and embark on a cruise through the Greek Islands. Enjoy the gorgeous scenery of pristine beaches and blue ocean waters. You will arrive at Mykonos, a charming town filled with restaurants, boutiques, and old-world appeal. Enjoy dinner on your own in Mykonos or on the ship. Return to the cruise ship for overnight.



Today, you arrive at the Turkish port of Kusadasi to visit the ancient city of Ephesus. Explore the Roman Terrace Houses with their stunning mosaics, the Great Theatre, which could hold 24,000 people and where St. Paul preached, and follow the Arcadian Way to the harbor. After lunch on the ship, head to Skala Harbor in Patmos to see the cave where St. John wrote the book of Revelation. Return to the ship for dinner and overnight stay.

Day 10 | Rhodes

Today, you arrive on the island of Rhodes, where beautiful beaches, castles, and ancient civilizations effortlessly mix with traditional cuisine and countless shops. You will have the day to enjoy wandering through the medieval city and lunch on your own if you don't want to return to the boat for lunch. You will return to the ship for dinner and overnight.

Day 11 | Crete | Santorini

This morning, you will visit Heraklion, where St. Paul was warned by the ship's owner and captain about continuing his journey to spread Christianity in Rome. You will see the church of St. Titus, a disciple of St. Paul and the first bishop in Crete. Next, you will embark on the ship that will take us to the stunning island of Santorini, highlighted by the volcanic crater barely submerged in the sea. The island of Santorini is home to many shops and open-air cafes scattered among scenic white houses. Enjoy dinner on your own in Santorini or aboard the ship. You will return to the cruise ship overnight.

Day 12 | Corinth

After disembarking from your cruise, you'll visit Ancient Corinth, where Paul established a church. After passing through the Corinth Canal, you'll explore the Archaeological Museum and the Temples, including the Bema where he faced the Roman governor. Next, you'll head to Mycenae, known for its rich archaeological finds. You'll see the Tomb of Agamemnon, the Lion Gate, and the Acropolis. The day concludes with a farewell dinner in the hotel roof garden, followed by an overnight stay.

Day 13 | Return Flight Home

After breakfast, you will be picked up from your hotel and transferred to Athens International Airport to catch your flight back home.

Signing Up

- Submit a non-refundable \$750 deposit along with a copy of your registration form and passport.
- Names on the registration form and passport must match exactly.
- U.S. passports must be current up to six months after the return date.
- Full payment is due 06/13/25 (100 days before departure).

No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport.
