PROGRAM CONDITIONS

INCLUDED IN PRICE OF STANDARD PROGRAM: Round trip airfare, transfers with group to/from airport; shared double room in moderate hotel; two meals daily; English speaking guide; transfer to and entrance fees for sites to be visited.

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE: Tips of \$250 to be collected and distributed by tour operator; Single room charges (see below); Additions or changes to the standard program (see below); individual transfers; travel insurance; laundry, coffee and drinks; excess baggage and items of a personal nature; any increase in taxes and fees that may occur between the printing of this brochure and issuing of airline tickets. Price is based on the exchange rate at the time of printing and may be subject to change. Additional charge of \$225 for double and \$288 for single to pay by credit card.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE: Deposit of \$750 due with registration. Final payment is due December 15, 2021.

SINGLE ROOMS: When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. Single room supplement is \$1400.

ROOMMATES: You will be charged for a single room if you do not have a roommate and/or Omega Travel cannot match you with one.

MEALS: Buffet breakfast and set menu dinner daily. All other meals are "on your own".

LUGGAGE: Limit of one suitcase and one carry-on per person, not to exceed 50 pounds or 62 inches total.

TRANSFERS: Transport between airport, hotel and piers is included in the standard program. However, those who request changes from standard program are responsible for their own transfers even when coinciding with group transfers.

CHANGES FROM STANDARD PROGRAM: Changes must be requested and approved in writing by Omega Travel. A minimum of \$150 will be charged and transfers to/from airports, etc. are not included.

AIRLINE TICKETS: Printed 45 days prior to departure, tickets cannot be changed or refunded thereafter. Air transportation to/from your European destination will be jet economy class aboard IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amenable tickets for groups of 10 or more passengers flying together for entire itinerary.

FLIGHT TIMES: Subject to change by airlines without advance notice. Omega Travel is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays.

ITINERARY LENGTH: Because airlines often change flight schedules after brochures are printed, Omega Travel reserves the right to shorten or lengthen the itinerary accordingly and, whenever possible, you will be notified in writing. If changes necessitate extra overnights, there will be additional charges.

CANCELLATION FEES: From the day of registration to 120 days prior to departure the \$250 non-refundable registration fee is the only charge. Thereafter, the following charges apply: 119-90 days: \$750; 89-60 days: 50% of total cost; 59-45 days: 75% of total cost; 44 days to day of departure: 100% of total cost. All refund claims must be received in writing.

ITINERARY

Monday, March 28 - Your journey begins as you depart Houston Intercontinental Airport on your international flight.

Tuesday, March 29 - You will be welcomed by our representative in **Thessaloniki** and go to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Wednesday, March 30 - Today you will drive to **Philippi**, the leading city in Macedonia during Paul's time. It was there that Paul and Silas met Lydia, a wealthy woman who invited them to use her home as a meeting place for the local believers. You will see the cell where Paul and Silas were imprisoned and other archaeological sites in the area. You'll continue from there to **Kavalla**, the site of the ancient port of **Neapolis** where Paul arrived on his first journey to Macedonia. You will have some time to stroll around this scenic port lined with cafés and shops. On the way back to Thessaloniki you will visit the **old city ramparts** in the upper part of the city before returning to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Thursday, Mach 31 - Today you will tour **Thessaloniki** where Paul preached and founded a church. You will visit the **St. George Church** (an ancient Roman monument transformed into a church), and the **Galerius Arch** which rises over the famous **Via Egnatia**. You will then visit the **Church of St. Demetrios**, built on the ruins of the ancient synagogue where Paul reasoned with the Jews. You will continue to **Vergina** where you will visit the unique **Tomb of Philip of Macedon**, the father of Alexander the Great. From there you will travel to **Kalambaka** for dinner and overnight.

Friday, April 1 - This morning you will visit **Meteora** where world-famous **Byzantine monasteries** perch precariously atop rock formations of varied and beautiful shapes. You will visit two of these monasteries which seem to hang in the air. After your visit there you will go to **Delphi**. The road will take you through Greek countryside up 1800 feet to Delphi for dinner and overnight.

Saturday, April 2 - This morning you will visit the ancient site of **Delphi**, the most spectacularly

beautiful ancient site in Greece. Regarded as the center of the world, believers came for 14 centuries to hear its oracle. You will take the **Sacred Way** to the **Athenian Treasury**, the **Temple of Apollo**, the **Theatre**, and other sites in this beautiful area. You will also visit the **Museum** where, among other treasures, you will see the unique **bronze charioteer**. After your visit in Delphi, you will drive to **Olympia** for dinner and overnight.

Sunday, April 3 - This morning you will begin your touring with a visit to the **Sanctuary of Zeus** at the site of the first Olympic Games. They were held in 776 BC - a contest between mortal heroes and the gods! From there you will go the **Archaeological Museum** to see the monumental items found during the excavations at the site. You'll then drive to **Athens** for dinner and overnight

Monday, April 4 - Today you explore the city of **Athens** as Paul did, visiting the world-renowned **Acropolis** and the ruins of the **Parthenon**, **Erectheum** and **Propylaea**, still one of the most splendid monuments of ancient Greece. You will visit **Mars Hill** and view the **Agora**, the ancient market place where Paul disputed with the philosophers. You will see today's Athens with its **House of Parliament**, the **Tomb of the Unknown Soldier** and the **Palace** before returning to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Tuesday, April 5 - This morning you will board a ship in the **Port of Piraeus**. It was here that Paul would have joined the sailors eagerly looking for the **gilded point of the spear of Athens**, whose statue once stood on the **Athenian Acropolis**. In the evening you will arrive at the **Island of Mykonos** with its celebrated windmills and picturesque houses.

Wednesday, April 6 - This morning you will arrive in **Kusadasi, Turkey** and journey on to **Ephesus**, the center of emperor worship, and (due to the work of Paul and John,) the center of Christianity in Asia Minor. You will visit the **Roman Terrace Houses** and see the **Temple of Diana (Artemis)**, one of the seven wonders of the ancient World. You will sail to **Patmos** for a visit

to the **Monastery of St. John** and **Grotto** where John wrote the **Book of Revelation**.

Thursday, April 7 - Today you will visit the **Island of Rhodes**. As Paul's ship sailed into the harbor he would have seen the remains of the one of the **Seven Wonders** of the ancient world – **Colossus**, a huge brazen statue of **Apollo** so high that ships passed in full sail between its legs. The Rhodians tell how Silas healed a paralytic hero on a visit to this island. You will have an excursion to **Lindos** where you will learn about the layers of civilization there and visit the acropolis of Lindos. You will also visit **Knight's Street** where you will learn about the history of the knights on Rhodes. You will have some free time to wander the streets of the port city before heading back to the ship.

Friday, April 8 - This morning you will visit the **Island of Crete**. You will have the morning free to explore **Heraklion**, the capital of Crete, or you may want to take an excursion. This afternoon you will cruise to **Santorini**, perhaps the most breathtaking of all the Greek Islands.

Saturday, April 9 - Today you will disembark after breakfast and travel to the famous **Corinth Canal**. In Paul's time ships were dragged overland on rollers. In the **Ancient City of Corinth** where Paul visited three times and established a vigorous church, you will visit the **Archaeological Museum**, and the **Temples**. In the center of the Agora is the **Bema** where Paul was brought before the Roman governor. You will travel to **Mycenae**, a city which Homer called 'rich in gold' and has provided one of the richest archaeological discoveries ever made. You will see the beehive **Tomb of Agamemnon**, the famous **Lion Gate** and the **Acropolis**. You will then return to Athens for your **Farewell Dinner**.

Sunday, April 10 - After breakfast you will go to the airport for your international flight and return home with a new understanding of the **Apostle Paul**.
