**June 15<sup>th</sup>:** Depart Houston Intercontinental Airport.

**June 16<sup>th</sup>:** Arrival Zagreb airport. Transfer to Ljubljana. (143 km)  
Check in. Walk with your tour manager in the old town.  
Welcome dinner

### **June 17<sup>th</sup>: Morning excursion to Schloss Turjak**

The Turjak castle is one of the mightiest castles in the former Kranjska area and is closely connected to Slovenian literary history. Afternoon free time. Evening Concert

### **June 18<sup>th</sup>: Ljubljana – Stud Piber – Graz – Deutschlandsberg**

Breakfast and transfer to Graz/Deutschlandsberg with a stop and visit the Stud Piber. From here, the Lipizan horses are spending their “youth” before they go to Vienna to the Hofreitschule. Guided Tour.



Lipizzaners are Europe’s oldest cultural horse breed, with their origin going back to the year 1580. The Lipizzaner stud Piber combines

knowledge that has been accumulated over 400 years with a feeling for Lipizzaners to breed horses with the abilities that make them world-famous, especially through the Spanish Riding School. Continue on to Deutschlandsberg, in a beautiful town surrounded by the vineyards. Overnight and typical Styrian dinner (breaded chicken, salad, bread, wine)

**June 19th: Deutschlandsberg - Graz – Stainz – Deutschlandsberg**

Morning excursion to Graz with a visit to the Schlossberg, the old town and relaxing /shopping time. Early afternoon transfer to Stainz (concert). Return to Deutschlandsberg for overnight.

**June 20th: Deutschlandsberg - Bad Ischl - Salzburg**

Breakfast. Transfer to Salzburg with a lunch stop in Bad Ischl. The little town of Bad Ischl in Upper Austria, the former summer capital of the great Austro-Hungarian Monarchy, has been associated with the Habsburg imperial dynasty for at least 700 years. The Imperial Villa in Ischl, the Emperor's summer residence, was described by Franz Josef I as "heaven on earth" for himself and his family.



Continue on to Salzburg – along the beautiful Salzkammergut. Check in. Dinner. Walk with tour manager.

## **June 21st Salzburg**

Morning city tour. Informal singing in Salzburg Cathedral. Afternoon free. Dinner

**June 22nd** Drive to Oberammergau and get settled in your hotel. Dinner and overnight.

**June 23rd** Free morning to explore the village of Oberammergau before the Passion Play. Dinner and overnight.

## **June 24th Oberammergau – Munich**

Breakfast. Transfer to Munich with a visit to Füssen, Neuschwanstein Palace and Hohenschwangau. Check in Munich. Dinner in a Löwenbräuhaus.

## **June 25th Munich city tour**

Morning free time. City tour in Munich. Informal singing in one of the beautiful churches. Dinner

## **June 26th Departure**

Morning flight to return to the USA.

### **PROGRAM CONDITIONS**

**INCLUDED IN PRICE OF STANDARD PROGRAM:** Round trip airfare, transfers with group to/from airport; shared double room in moderate hotel; two meals daily; English speaking guide; transfer to and entrance fees for sites to be visited, border taxes and visa fees.

**NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE:** Tips of \$225 to be collected and distributed by tour operator; Single room charges (see below); Additions or changes to the standard program (see below); individual transfers; travel insurance; laundry, coffee and drinks; excess baggage and items of a personal nature; **any increase in taxes and fees that may occur between the printing of this brochure and issuing of airline tickets.** Price is based on the exchange rate at the time of printing and may be subject to change.

**PAYMENT SCHEDULE:** Deposit of \$750 due with registration. Second deposit of \$500 due September 10, 2021; third deposit of \$500 due December 15, 2021. **Final payment is due March 10, 2022.**

**SINGLE ROOMS:** When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. Single room supplement is \$800.

**ROOMMATES:** You will be charged for a single room if you do not have a roommate and/or Gomega Travel cannot match you with one.

**MEALS:** Breakfast daily and dinners are included. All other meals are “on your own”.

**LUGGAGE:** Limit of one suitcase and one carry-on per person, not to exceed 50 pounds or 62 inches total.

**TRANSFERS:** Transport between airport, hotel and piers is included in the standard program. However, those who request changes from standard program are responsible for their own transfers even when coinciding with group transfers.

**CHANGES FROM STANDARD PROGRAM:** Changes must be requested and approved in writing by Gomega Travel. A minimum of \$150 will be charged and transfers to/from airports, etc. are not included.

**AIRLINE TICKETS:** Printed 45 days prior to departure, tickets cannot be changed or refunded thereafter. Air transportation to/from your European destination will be jet economy class aboard IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amenable tickets for groups of 10 or more passengers flying together for entire itinerary.

**FLIGHT TIMES:** Subject to change by airlines without advance notice. Gomega Travel is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays.

**ITINERARY LENGTH:** Because airlines often change flight schedules after brochures are printed, Gomega Travel reserves the right to shorten or lengthen the itinerary accordingly and, whenever possible, you will be notified in writing. If changes necessitate extra overnights, there will be additional charges.

**CANCELLATION FEES:** From the day of registration all deposits will be non-refundable.
