**Itinerary** (included meals B=breakfast, D=dinner)

**Day 1 – Friday, September 2, 2022 LAX to Munich**  
Depart the U.S. to Munich, Germany.

**Day 2 – Saturday, September 3, 2022 Munich**  
After arrival claim your luggage and proceed through customs. Meet your tour director and start exploring Munich on a city sightseeing tour. Check in at your hotel. Later tonight enjoy your dinner in a local restaurant. (D)

**Day 3 – Sunday, September 4, 2022 Munich**  
Attend a Church service. The rest of the day is free for individual activities. You could participate in a half day walking tour of the Dachau Memorial or visit the Pinakothek Art Museum or the Bavarian National Museum. Another option would be an evening concert or opera or just strolling through town (All admission prices are not included in the tour price). (B)

**Day 4 – Monday, September 5, 2022 Munich - Oberammergau**  
Depart Munich and drive south into the wonder world of the Alps. First stop is the town of Fussen. Only a short drive from here is King Ludwigs Castle of Neuschwanstein which we will visit. Late afternoon arrival in Oberammergau. (B, D)

**Day 5 – Tuesday, September 6, 2022 Oberammergau**



This morning is free to explore the village. You might want to do some shopping, Oberammergau has a great woodcarving tradition. After lunch (on your own) experience history first hand and attend the Passion Play, performed only every 10 years since 1634. (B, D)

**Day 6 – Wednesday, September 7, 2022 Oberammergau - Nuremberg**

Depart Oberammergau and drive north to Nuremberg where a local guide will meet you for a walking tour through the old historic part of the town. Enjoy the historic market square with its many flower and fruit stands, the colorful fountain, the new town hall and the Church of St. Lawrence. Stop at the Durer House where the famous artist lived from 1509 to 1528. See the fortress giving you a wonderful view over the historical part of the city. The balance of the day is free. You might want to visit the famous toy museum or try some of the freshly baked Gingerbread, manufactured right here in Nuremberg and shipped all over the world. Another specialty is the Nuremberg sausage sold by street vendors as well as served by many restaurants in town. Church service at your hotel. (B, D)

**Day 7 – Thursday, September 8, 2022 Nuremberg - Prague**

Cross the border into the Czech Republic and drive to the capital of Prague. Meet your local guide for a sightseeing tour of the old town featuring Wenceslaus Square, the center of the city, lying between old and modern Prague and Charles University, the oldest in central Europe. (B, D)

**Day 8 – Friday, September 9, 2022 Prague**

This morning visit Hradcany Castle and the Gothic St. Vitus Cathedral where building began in 1344. Also see Strahov Monastery with its remarkable astronomical clock, and the lovely bridges over the gentle Vltava River. Afternoon at leisure to visit one of Prague's art museum's or just for shopping for the famous Bohemian crystal. (B)

**Day 9 – Saturday, September 10, 2022 Prague – Dresden**

Back into Germany. Your destination is Dresden. A local guide will take you on a walking tour to show you the exciting sights. Pragerstrasse is the town center with boulevards of gardens and fountains lined with modern shops. This street leads to the Altmarkt, the historic town center. From here the streets are lined with historic buildings, like the Semper Gallery of Old Masters paintings, the Albertinum Gallery of New Masters, the Green Vault with treasures from the 16th, 17th and 18th century. The Zwinger complex also is the home of one of the largest porcelain collections. Also see the Semper Opera House, the Church of the Cross, home of Dresden's famous boys choir and the Church of our Lady. (B, D)

**Day 10 – Sunday, September 11, 2020 Dresden – Wittenberg - Berlin**

This morning church service at your hotel. After that departure to Wittenberg where a local guide will show you the sights of Wittenberg. The tour will end at the Luther House. Continue to Berlin where you arrive in the early evening. (B, D)

**Day 11 – Monday, September 12, 2022 Berlin**

Morning sightseeing tour. Highlights are the imposing Reichstag, the Olympic Stadium, where Jesse Owens raced to glory in 1936, the Schoeneberger Rathaus, site of John F. Kennedy moving "Ich bin ein Berliner" speech. Checkpoint Charlie and centuries old churches and monuments. One of the highlights is your drive along the boulevard "Unter den Linden." Starting at the Brandenburg Gate pass famous buildings such as the State Opera House, the Humboldt University and the Cathedral ending at Alexanderplatz with its TV tower. (B)

**Day 12 – Tuesday, September 13, 2022 Berlin**

Today visit Museum Island, home to 5 museums including the Pergamont Museum which houses antiquities from Turkey. (Although partially closed to renovation, we will be able to visit some special exhibits during the remodel). (B)

**Day 13 – Wednesday, September 14, 2022 Berlin - USA**

Transfer to Berlin's Tegel airport for your return flight to the U.S. (B)

- Accommodations in superior tourist class and first class hotels, double occupancy (Maritim Hotel, Munich, Oberammergau Hotel assigned by the Passion Play office app. 60 days before, Ringhotel Loew's Merkur, Nuremberg, K+K Hotel Fenix, Prague, Hotel Am Terrassenufer, Dresden, Hotel Hilton in Berlin)
- Porterage of one suitcase at hotels (if available)
- Services of an experienced English speaking tour director throughout (gratuity not included)
- Transportation by private motor coach including all driver expenses except his gratuity

## **PROGRAM CONDITIONS**

**INCLUDED IN PRICE OF STANDARD PROGRAM:** Round trip airfare, transfers with group to/from airport; shared double room in Superior Tourist Class and First Class hotels; meals as outlined in the itinerary; English speaking guide; transfer to and entrance fees for sites to be visited.

**NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE:** Tips of \$225 to be collected and distributed by tour operator; single room charges (see below); additions or changes to the standard program (see below); individual transfers; travel insurance; laundry, coffee and drinks; passport/visa fees; excess baggage and items of a personal nature;

**PAYMENT SCHEDULE:** Deposit of \$750 due with registration. Second deposit of \$700 per person due December 15. Deposits are non-refundable. Final payment is due May 20, 2022.

**SINGLE ROOMS:** When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. Single room supplement for this tour will be announced when pricing is available.

**ROOMMATES:** You will be charged for a single room if you do not have a roommate and/or Gomega Travel cannot match you with one.

**MEALS:** Meals as indicated on itinerary. All other meals are “on your own”.

**LUGGAGE:** Limit of one suitcase and one carry-on per person, not to exceed 50 pounds or 62 inches total.

**TRANSFERS:** Transport between airport, hotel and piers is included in the standard program. However, those who request changes from standard program are responsible for their own transfers even when coinciding with group transfers.

**CHANGES FROM STANDARD PROGRAM:** Changes must be requested and approved in writing by Gomega Travel. A minimum of \$150 will be charged and transfers to/from airports, etc. are not included.

**AIRLINE TICKETS:** Printed 45 days prior to departure, tickets cannot be changed or refunded thereafter. Air transportation to/from your European destination will be jet economy class aboard IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amenable tickets for groups of 10 or more passengers flying together for entire itinerary.

**FLIGHT TIMES:** Subject to change by airlines without advance notice. Gomega Travel is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays.
